Old City Philadelphia

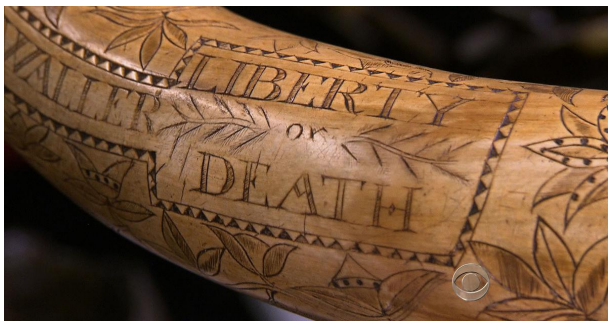

The Museum of the American Revolution is located just steps from Independence Hall in the heart of Historic Philadelphia. It brings the stories of our nation's founding to life in exciting and unique ways. The museum holds an expansive collection of art, manuscripts and printed works from the nation's Revolutionary Period as well as thousands of objects gathered from this time period. You will have approx. two hours to tour the museum on your own. After your self-guided tour, our group has reservations at 12noon for a wonderful lunch in the historic City Tavern.

After lunch, you will have some time on your own to visit the Liberty Bell and the Philadelphia Visitors Center before we depart for home.



Bus departs from Independence Park (adjacent to the Stony Brook Elem. School). The cost is \$ 86 per person (\$75 for Hopewell Twp. Residents) which includes admission, transportation, and the lunch at City Tavern!
