National 9/11 MEMORIAL and Museum



Tuesday, Sept. 19th

8:30am - 5:30pm

The *National September 11 Memorial* is a tribute of remembrance and honor to the nearly 3,000 people killed in the terror attacks of September 11, 2001. The Memorial's twin reflecting pools are each nearly an acre in size and feature the largest manmade waterfalls in North America. The *National September 11 Museum*, also located at this site, bears solemn witness to the terrorist attacks of Sept. 11, 2001 and February 26, 1993. The Museum offers displays of artifacts from the WTC and 9/11 attacks, interactive exhibitions, contemplative areas, and programs that convey individual and collective stories relating the experiences of survivors, responders, area residents, and eyewitnesses.



We have timed entry tickets for the Museum at 11:00am. There will be sufficient time to spend in the Museum and at the Memorial Reflecting Pools. Lunch will be on your own at one of the many eateries that are close by the Memorial Site. We will depart for home at 3:30pm.

Cost is \$56 per person (**\$49 for Hopewell Township residents**) and includes motor coach transportation and admission passes to the Memorial Site & Museum. Trip departs from Independence Park (adjacent to Stony Brook Elementary School) promptly at 8:30am.
