- Begins July 10 and ends August 4.
- Sign-up for one week or multiple weeks.

- Trips depart from and return to Timberlane Middle School each day.

- Registration fees are between \$315 and \$345/week. Fee includes transportation, admissions, and staffing (and lunch when stated on weekly schedule).
- Participants are entrusted with levels of independence which **do not** require them to be with staff members at all time. Staff will give instructions daily for designated check-in times.
- Parent & Camper Open House is provided on Tues. June 13 at 7pm in the Hopewell Twp. municipal building auditorium. Review of program and Q&A session.
- \$100 deposit/per camper/per week due by May 12, 2017. All registrations must be paid in full by Friday, June 30. If you are signing up for multiple weeks, we will work with you to provide a payment schedule.
- **Refund Policy:** Registrants who withdraw prior to the start of a program may be issued a refund only if the HTPRD is notified in writing at least ten (10) working days prior to the event or start of the program. NO REFUNDS will be granted once a program has begun. A \$20 administrative service charge will be deducted from all refunds granted. There are no refunds for participants who are absent.
