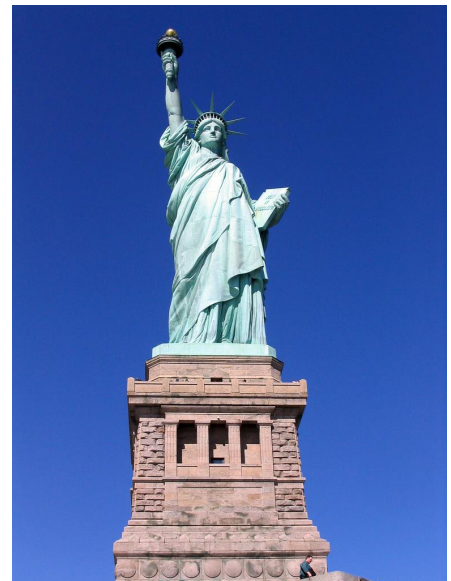
ELLIS ISLAND & LIBERTY ISLAND

**Tuesday, May 23rd
8:30 am - 5:30 pm**



Ellis Island was America's largest and most active immigration station where over 12 million immigrants were processed from 1892 to 1924. This "Island of Hope" was the first stop on their way to new opportunities in America. For the rest, it became the "Island of Tears" - a place where families were separated or denied entry into the United States. The Museum Collection of the Statue of Liberty National Monument and Ellis Island includes close to 400,000 artifacts which represent the cultural and natural histories of both islands.

There will be time to explore, attend a Park Ranger guided tour or take a self-guided audio tour. Our tickets will also include entry into the pedestal of the Statue of Liberty which is roughly half the height of the entire monument. An elevator will take us to the top of the pedestal for panoramic views of Ellis Island, New York, New Jersey and the New York Harbor. There are options at either park for lunch on your own.



Cost of the trip is \$49 (\$43 for Hopewell Twp. residents) and includes motor coach transportation, ferry service and admissions. The trip departs from Independence Park on Stephenson Rd. and adjacent to the Stony Brook Elementary School.
