

2017 SKATE CAMP



- ◇ **Tom Woodrow** returns for his 11th summer as Camp Director bringing along a staff of experienced skateboard instructors who will introduce basic skateboarding fundamentals as well as safety, equipment use, and proper etiquette in the skate park. These sessions are geared to the beginner through intermediate level skaters and are open to girls and boys ages 7-15.
- ◇ Skaters will learn and develop the skills of skating on flat ground, stopping, steering, rolling down small flat ramps and stand-still ollieing. More experienced skaters will learn techniques such as dropping in, kickflips, heelflips and more.
- ◇ Participants must provide their own skateboard and safety equipment. They will be required to wear knee pads, elbow pads, and a helmet. All skaters should bring water & a snack. Registration limited to 12 participants per week.

Release, Waiver, Hold Harmless, and Indemnification Agreement: We, as the Parents/Legal Guardians of the participant, on behalf the participant and ourselves, personal representatives, assigns, heirs, next of kin, guardians, conservators, executors, etc., in consideration of the participant being permitted to participate in the Skate Camp Program, acknowledge, understand and agree to the following:

- That skateboarding is an inherently dangerous sport/activity in which we choose to voluntarily participate at our own risk and we fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs and damages that may be incurred as a result of participation in the activity. These risks and dangers may be caused by our own actions, inactions, negligence or gross negligence; the conditions in which the activity takes place; or the action, inaction, negligence or gross negligence of others.
- We agree to release, waive, hold harmless, and indemnify the Township of Hopewell, its agents, contractors, subcontractors, and employees, the Hopewell Township Parks and Recreation Department, its agents, contractors, subcontractors, and employees, and other such individuals who may be involved in the planning and implementation of the program (hereinafter "Township") from any and all liability, claims, demands, or causes of action, for any and all losses or damages which may result from participation in this program, which may be caused or alleged to be caused, in whole or in part, by the action, inaction, negligence or gross negligence of the Township.
- We further acknowledge and agree that if despite this agreement we, or anyone acting on our behalf, makes a claim against the Township, we will indemnify, save and hold harmless the Township from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, losses, liability, damages or costs which any may incur as the result of such claim.

We have read this Agreement, fully understand its terms, and understand that we have given up substantial rights by signing it, and have signed it freely and voluntarily without any oral representations, statements, inducements or assurances of any nature, and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent possible and allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.
