



I am writing in response to your March 1, 2016 letter to Chairman Bay regarding the PennEast Pipeline Project. In your letter, you state that PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC's (PennEast) response to Data Request No. 38 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC) November 24, 2015 Environmental Information Request was incorrect and that PennEast has not contacted all relevant historical organizations. PennEast believes that it correctly responded to Data Request No. 38. As directed by Data Request No. 38, PennEast's response provides the consultation documentation with local historical advisory committees, local historical societies, and other potential stakeholders that had been sent as of the date of the response (December 14, 2015). PennEast continues to provide updated copies of this information to FERC upon request and to the relevant townships when it is appropriate to do so. If you feel that PennEast should be communicating with other committees or organizations within your township, I invite you to contact me with those suggestions.
