Featuring 250 breathtaking acres of curated gardens and displays, the New York Botanical Gardens is one of the greatest botanical gardens in the world and the largest in any city in the United States. It is distinguished by the beauty of its diverse landscape and extensive collections and gardens. Upon arrival, our group will depart on a narrated Garden Tram Tour offering a relaxing and informative way to see much of this National Historic Landmark's beautiful natural terrain, including dramatic rock outcroppings, a river and waterfall, ponds, and rolling hills. Once the tram tour is completed, you will be able to explore any part of 50 diverse gardens and collections as well as the conservatory on your own.

The Enid A. Haupt Conservatory houses a tropical rain forest, a cactus-filled desert, and an ever changing landscape of magnificent flowers and lush foliage in the nation's premier Victorian-style glasshouse. The Conservatory also hosts the Botanical Garden's popular seasonal flower shows and exhibitions.

Lunch will be on your own with choices at the Pine Tree Café (Panini, salad, sandwiches) or the Hudson Garden Grill (full-service, sit-down dining).



Cost is \$56 per person (\$49 for Hopewell Twp. Residents) and includes admission, garden tram tour and motor coach transportation. Trip departs from Independence Park (adjacent to the Stony Brook Elementary School in Brandon Farms). Please arrive by 8:15am for check-in.
