Eight point six miles long and a century-and-a-half back in time, the Secret Valley Line beckons you to experience the unexpected treasures of Pennsylvania.

The Secret Valley is one of the most scenic and historic regions in the Northeast, traversing geological formations and lands rich with Native American lore. The Colebrookdale railroad connects the sites of the earliest iron-making industries in the American colonies crossing timber trestles and mountain creeks on its timeless journey into the past. We will have the exclusive use of their 40-passenger dining car and enjoy a fine lunch during our excursion.
