- Begins July 9 and ends August 3.
- Sign-up for one week or multiple weeks.
- 9am to 4pm most days (some days are later)
- Trips depart from and return to Timberlane Middle School each day.
- Sign-up with your friends and have a great summer!!
- Registration fees are between \$325 and \$355/week. Fee includes transportation, admissions, and staffing (and lunch when stated on weekly schedule).
- Participants are entrusted with levels of independence which **do not** require them to be with staff members at all time. Staff will give instructions daily for designated check-in times.
- Parent & Camper Orientation is provided on Thurs. June 21 at 7pm in the Hopewell Twp. municipal building auditorium. Review of program and Q&A session.
- \$100 deposit/per camper/per week due by May 14, 2018. All registrations must be paid in full by Friday, June 22. If you are signing up for multiple weeks, we will work with you to provide a payment schedule.
- **Refund Policy:** Registrants who withdraw prior to the start of a program may be issued a refund only if the HTPRD is notified in writing at least ten (10) working days prior to the event or start of the program. NO REFUNDS will be granted once a program has begun. A \$20 administrative service charge will be deducted from any refund granted. There are no refunds for participants who are absent.
