The Charms of Fairmount Park Historic House Tour

Within the grounds of Fairmount Park in Philadelphia, are six “Charms” - the houses maintained as historic house museums. These houses served as summer villas for well-to-do families during the 18th and 19th centuries. We will be touring three of the six “Charms” decorated in all of their holiday splendor.

Our Holiday touring will begin at Laurel Hill which sits on a high bluff overlooking the Schuylkill River. The beautiful Georgian home was the home of a Philadelphia Mayor and was seized during the Revolution and later regained by the family.

We will break for lunch at the nearby London Grill for a three course meal including salad, choice of entrée, dessert, coffee & tea.

In the afternoon, our touring continues at Woodford; an elegant Georgian country home that houses a collection of furniture and household items of the Colonial years. Our final stop of the day takes us to Strawberry Mansion; the largest of the “Charm” houses. The mansion’s interior contains elaborate Federal-style woodwork and two large floors filled with an impressive array of furniture, decorative arts, and antique toys.



Cost of the trip is \$95 (\$84 for Hopewell Twp. residents) and includes motor coach transportation, lunch, and all tour admissions. The trip departs from Independence Park on Stephenson Rd. and adjacent to the Stony Brook Elementary School.
