


Join the Hopewell Township Parks & Recreation Department as we travel to....

Nestled in the heart of the Brandywine Valley is the beautiful 1,000 acre estate of Henry Francis du Pont called Winterthur. Our visit will begin with a 30-minute narrated Garden Tram Tour through du Pont's masterful 60-acre garden. The next part of our visit will be a guided tour of the Mansion to view elegantly furnished rooms in which du Pont entertained his family and friends in grand style!



Lunch will be on your own at the Visitor Center Garden Café. We will conclude our visit with time on your own to stroll the gardens, view the exhibits in the Galleries including the Campbell Collections of Soup Tureens, or spend some time browsing or shopping an outstanding collection of gifts, books and home décor in the Museum Store.

Cost for this community trip is \$ 52 (\$45 for HT Residents) and includes round-trip motor coach transportation and 2 guided tours. We depart promptly at 8am from Independence Park which is located on Stephenson Road, adjacent to the Stony Brook Elementary School in Brandon Farms.
