WHEREAS, existing centerline pavement markings permit overtaking and passing of vehicles along certain portions of County Route 579 (Bear Tavern Road) along and approaching the frontage of the Bear Tavern Elementary School in Hopewell Township; and,

WHEREAS, the Township of Hopewell has requested Mercer County to revise said pavement markings to establish and maintain a "No Passing Zone" in both directions; and,

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has conducted an investigation of centerline pavement markings and has determined that the establishment of said "No Passing Zones" is in the interest and safety of the expeditious flow of traffic and conforms to the current standards prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as adopted by the commissioner; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, that "No Passing Zones" shall be established as follows:

County Route 579 (Bear Tavern Road) Hopewell Township

- a. No Passing Zone lines shall be installed in both directions of County Route 579 from Jacobs Creek Road to the Mercer County/Hopewell Township jurisdictional line for an approximate distance of 23,790 feet or 4.5 miles.

and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board shall forward two (2) certified copies of this Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer for distribution and a copy of this Ordinance to the Director of the Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.






ORDINANCE NO. 2009-13

WHEREAS, the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. The speed limits for both directions of traffic along County Route #623 (Pennington-Harbourton Rd) between Trenton - Harbourton Road (CR 579) and the Hopewell Township / Pennington Borough line situated in the Township of Hopewell, County of Mercer, be established as follows:

Zone 1: 45 M.P.H. between Trenton - Harbourton Road (CR 579) and a point 1,750 feet east of Scotch Road

Zone 2: 35 M.P.H. from a point 600 feet west of South Timberlane Drive to the Hopewell Township / Pennington Borough line.

2. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board of Chosen Freeholders shall forward three (3) certified copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer and one (1) certified copy to the Director, Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure.
