

Please be advised that on or about **April 18, 2011** milling and resurfacing work on **Pennington-Rocky Hill Road (County Route 624) from Elm Ridge Road to Titus Mill Road will commence**. During construction, this section of Pennington-Rocky Hill Road will be closed to through traffic from approximately 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., weekdays only.

Northbound traffic will be detoured on Pennington-Rocky Hill Road, Carter Road and Elm Ridge Road. Southbound traffic will travel above route conversely. Motorists should expect delays in construction area. Emergency access and access for businesses and residents would be permitted during this time. On-street parking would be restricted as needed. Mercer County anticipates that this work will take approximately five (5) working days, weather permitting.
