At their meeting on 10/6/15, the Borough Council, of Freemansburg Borough, Northampton County, PA directed me to send this letter in the support of the position that the Bethlehem Authority has taken.

Freemansburg residents are among 1000+ customers of high-quality drinking water supplied by the Bethlehem Authority each day. We are extremely concerned about the potential negative impact that a construction or operational event along the pipeline route could have on the Authority's watershed and its facilities.

The Borough Council support the findings of the Mater Report, recommending that PennEast redesign the pipeline route to completely avoid the Authority's watershed, reservoirs and water transmission lines to the fullest extent possible.
