Basis for Intervening:

As Co-owner of Durham Press, Inc. I would hereby like to request to be an intervenor in the PennEast Pipeline docket CP15-558-00.

Durham Press is located in close proximity to the proposed pipeline and will be adversely affected by its construction and use. We employ many people who also live in close proximity to the pipeline who are very concerned by its placement in our watershed. We rely on well water and are all well aware how sensitive our aquifers are in this Karst region.

Durham Press was intentionally located in this community because of its peaceful, natural beauty. It's spectacular here. Our clients come from around the world and have all expressed deep sadness and concern over the placement of this pipeline and its route through this pristine land. They also are sad to learn about this senseless and dangerous push to force un-needed polluting fuels into our world, when most of us are excited to move in the opposite direction.

We will be soon installing solar panels at our facility and are among the many in our community who are ready to move in a new direction and do not want the expansion of drilling and pipelines. We are concerned for our children and for our futures. Expansion of pipelines is the wrong direction for our community and for our world. There are now better, safer choices and FERC needs to consider that this is no longer "needed" and therefore should not be "forced" on the public. The opposition is growing in every corner.

We firmly oppose the construction of the PennEast Pipeline and therefore request that the Commission grant this motion to intervene on the behalf of Durham Press, Inc.
