**Re: FERC Docket No CP15-558 "PennEast Pipeline"**

In the Matter of the 7 (c) Application by PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC concerning its proposed PennEast Pipeline ("PennEast"), Enerplus Corporation and its affiliate, Enerplus Resources (USA) Corporation ("Enerplus") wish to indicate our support for the project.

Enerplus is a publicly traded North American energy producer listed on the New York Stock Exchange (ERF). Our U.S. activities in the Marcellus are focused within four counties in north east Pennsylvania; Susquehanna, Bradford, Wyoming, and Lycoming. We have approximately 200 million cubic feet per day that is delivered onto both Tennessee Gas Pipeline ("TGP") and Transcontinental Pipeline ("Transco").

Given the historic and the projected production capability for the region as a whole over the next few years, the proposed PennEast Project is required to provide Enerplus and others a critical conduit of pipeline egress from the region. The PennEast Pipeline will be beneficial to both natural gas consumers and producers. This important new pipeline infrastructure will support secure and reliable energy supply for the New Jersey consumers. It was the ability to access incremental market growth at a reasonable cost that resulted in Enerplus making a long term commitment to the project. Enerplus is currently looking to conclude term supply arrangements with downstream markets that would be contingent on using our capacity on this project.

Enerplus supports both the timely approval of the PennEast Project as well as the development of the project in the future. Additionally, Enerplus reserves the right to participate as it deems necessary in any further regulatory process related to Docket CP15-558 or future matters related to the PennEast Pipeline project.
