Basis for Intervening:

Pursuant to Sections 212 and 214 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (the Commission), 18 C.F.R. § 385.212 and §385.214(b) (2014), FirstEnergy Service Company on behalf of its affiliates Jersey Central Light & Power Company, and Metropolitan Edison Company (collectively, FirstEnergy), hereby moves to intervene in this proceeding.

FirstEnergy Service Company is a subsidiary of FirstEnergy Corp., one of the nation's largest investor-owned electric utilities with a generating fleet of over 18,000 megawatts. As a transmission owner with real estate holdings in Pennsylvania and New Jersey, FirstEnergy would be directly affected by any decision in this docket. FirstEnergy has significant existing electric transmission and distribution lines, substations and associated infrastructure located along portions of the proposed pipeline route. Therefore, FirstEnergy has an interest in this proceeding that cannot adequately be represented by any other party, and the Commission should grant this motion to intervene.
