Dear Secretary Bose:

I write today on behalf of NRG REMA LLC (“NRG REMA”) to express our support for the approval and construction of the PennEast Pipeline (the “Project”) seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in the above referenced docket.

NRG REMA owns an approximately 540 MW (summer rating) natural gas-fired generating facility (the Gilbert Generating Station) located in Milford, New Jersey. NRG REMA has entered into a Precedent Agreement with PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC (“PennEast”) pursuant to which NRG REMA has the ability to obtain firm transportation service from the proposed PennEast Pipeline if the Project is constructed. The PennEast Pipeline will run in close proximity to the Gilbert Generating Station, making the proposed path of the Project an optimal location. The PennEast Pipeline would enhance the fuel transportation service available to the Gilbert Generating Station. As such, NRG REMA supports the PennEast Pipeline.
