

Our tribal nation is apprehensive over the potential environmental impact and potential disruption of historic indigenous sites, including New Jersey Indian Site #24-42-6-8-1, in the area of the planned construction.

Our tribal government requests that it be informed of plans to mitigate the potential negative environmental impact and disruption of historic sites, in addition to the uncovering of any artifacts or cultural remains of the Lenape in the project area.
