Basis for Intervening:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (PPL Electric) moves to intervene in this proceeding. PPL Electric is a Pennsylvania corporation and a wholly owned subsidiary of PPL Corporation. PPL Electric is an owner of transmission facilities in PJM Interconnection, LLC (PJM). PPL Electric distributes electricity to all retail customers within its service territory in central eastern Pennsylvania, and is a provider of last resort under Pennsylvania's Electricity Generation Customer Choice and Competition Act, 66 Pa.C.S.A. § 2801, et seq. PPL Electric is a load-serving entity (LSE) in PJM and a signatory to the PJM Consolidated Transmission Owners Agreement and the Reliability Assurance Agreement (RAA).

PPL Electric moves to intervene in this proceeding in which, on September 25, 2015, Penn East Pipeline Company, LLC filed an Application for Public Convenience and Necessity to construct, install, own, operate and maintain the approximately one hundred eighteen mile underground natural gas PennEast pipeline. The proposed construction corridor for the PennEast pipeline crosses through PPL Electric's service territory in several counties located in Northeastern Pennsylvania and is near, adjacent to or on property either owned by PPL Electric or property over which PPL Electric has existing right of way agreements. As such, PPL Electric has a direct interest in the outcome of this proceeding. Other participants in this proceeding may take positions on the issues that support their specific interests, and those positions may differ from the positions that PPL Electric may take. Therefore, PPL Electric will be affected directly by the outcome of this proceeding, and its interest in this proceeding cannot adequately be represented by any other entity. For that reason, PPL Electric respectfully requests leave to intervene and to be made a party to this proceeding.
