Additional Information on Project

Dear Ms. Bose:

On October 10, 2014, the Director of the Office of Energy Projects issued a letter in the above-referenced docket approving the request of PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC (“PennEast”) to commence the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“Commission”) Pre-filing Review Process of its proposed PennEast Pipeline Project. On March 30, 2015, PennEast filed updated USGS quadrangle maps (“Maps”) reflecting PennEast’s revised preferred route based on input from stakeholders. The following information is provided to clarify details contained in those maps.

The PennEast Pipeline Project consists of four sections of pipeline:

- The main PennEast pipeline is approximately 110.6 miles consisting entirely of 36-inch pipe. The municipalities crossed are shown below

- The Hellertown Lateral, which begins at approximately MP 68.6, consists of 2.1 miles of 24-inch pipe. The Hellertown Lateral will end at an interconnection with both UGI Utilities (shown as UGI-Leh on the Maps) and Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC (shown as TCO on the Maps). The Hellertown Lateral is located in Lower Saucon Township, Northampton County, PA.
- The Gilbert Lateral, which begins at approximately MP 76.6, consists of 0.6 miles of 12-inch pipe. The Gilbert Lateral will end at an interconnection with both Elizabethtown Gas (shown as Etown on the Maps) and NRG REMA LLC's Gilbert Generating Station (shown as Gilbert on the Maps). The Gilbert Lateral is located in Holland Township, Hunterdon County, NJ.
- The Lambertville Lateral, which begins at approximately MP 97.4, consists of 1.3 miles of 36-inch pipe. The Lambertville Lateral will end at an interconnection with both Texas Eastern Transmission, LP (shown as TETCO on the Maps) and Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC (shown as Algonquin on the Maps). The Lambertville Lateral is located in West Amwell Township, Hunterdon County, NJ.

In addition to the sections of pipeline, the project contains a number of associated facilities, including interconnections that require no lateral and mainline block valves. The location and description of these facilities are shown in the table below:

There are two potential locations for compressor sites, only one of which will be selected for construction. Both are located along the main pipeline alignment and require no additional laterals. The first option is located at approximately MP 25.5 and the second is located at approximately MP 26.0. Both potential locations are located in Kidder Township, Carbon County, NJ.
