Please accept this letter as the Pennsylvania Game Commission's (PGC) comments in response to the recently published DEIS and those portions of the proposed PennEast Pipeline Project located on State Game Lands Nos. 40, 91, 129 and 168 in Luzerne, Carbon and Northampton Counties, Pennsylvania.

The PGC has been in discussions with PennEast regarding this project since September of 2014, and we continue to negotiate the alignment and project footprint in good faith with PennEast to ensure that impacts to the game lands and their associated wildlife habitat and recreational uses are minimized to the greatest extent possible.

To that end, the PGC is hereby respectfully requesting that the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission condition any Certificate that may be issued for this project to require that PennEast follow the PGC's procedures and requirements for the siting of this pipeline and its associated right-of-way and workspaces on State Game Lands.
