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
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

Dear Mr. Pogorzelski:

In response to your recent inquiry regarding the terms under which ELSA might consider providing service to users in Hopewell Township, I would refer you to the recent Hamptons Agreement for the general framework of the Agreement. Specifically, the current capacity purchase price is \$45.00 per gallon based on the estimated daily flow. For example, a three bedroom home has an estimated flow of 300 gpd and it would cost the homeowner \$13,500.00 to purchase that capacity. The purchase price is subject to annual review and change.

Additionally, each user will pay a connection fee equal to 1.1 times the ELSA regular rate. The current connection fee is \$2,957 per edu and is subject to annual change.

A user charge will be charged by Ewing Township to Hopewell Township equal to 1.5 times the Ewing residential rate. Of course what Hopewell charges its residents will be determined by Hopewell.
