

I write to inform you that the Bear Tavern Road/Jacob's Creek Crossing Rural Historic District, in Hopewell and Ewing Townships, Mercer County was entered into the New Jersey Register of Historic Places on October 3, 2011. The New Jersey Register is the official list of New Jersey properties worthy of preservation. The Bear Tavern Road/Jacob's Creek Crossing Rural Historic District is now protected by the review process for public projects established by New Jersey Register of Historic Places Act (N.J.A.C. 7:4).

I am also pleased to inform you that the Bear Tavern Road/Jacob's Creek Crossing Rural Historic District was entered into the National Register of Historic Places on November 30, 2011.
