Dear Mayor Sandom:

Please be advised that on or about **Monday, April 28, 2014**, bridge repairs are scheduled to commence on the **Van Dyke Road Bridge (#234.1)**. Anticipated duration of this project is approximately three (3) months, weather permitting and will be completed by in-house personnel.

During this time, it will be necessary to close the bridge to all traffic on a 24/7 basis. Mercer County will install signs advising motorists of upcoming bridge repairs and detours. Eastbound traffic will be directed to travel Stony Brook Road north from Van Dyke Road to right onto Eastbound Mountain Church Road, right onto Southbound Hopewell Wertsville Road, right onto Featherbed Lane to left onto Van Dyke Road. Motorists traveling northbound will travel the same route conversely.
