**Re: Washington Crossing Road (County Route 546)**

Dear Mayor Sandom:

Please be advised that on or about April 29, 2013, milling and resurfacing work will begin on **Washington Crossing Road** from **Jacobs Creek Road** to **Scotch Road**. Mercer County anticipates that this work will take approximately ten (10) working days, weather permitting. During construction, this section of Washington Crossing Road will be closed to through traffic from approximately 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., weekdays only. However, emergency access and access for businesses and residents would be permitted during this time. The detour plan will be as follows:

**West End of Project:**

**From Jacobs Creek Road (at Washington Crossing Road) - Eastbound Traffic Only** permitted from Jacobs Creek Road to Scotch Road.

**East End of Project:**

**From Westbound Washington Crossing Road (at Scotch Road) - turn right onto Scotch Road; turn left onto Pennington-Harbourton ; turn left onto Bear Tavern Road; to Washington Crossing Road; END DETOUR.**


**Re: Washington Crossing Road (County Route 546)**
