Senior Tax Programs

\$250 Tax Reduction Program:

This program is through your local municipality. Available to residents if:

- If you are a Veteran during an active wartime period or If you are a Widow of a Veteran with active wartime service. To qualify you must fill out the Property Tax Deduction Claim by Veteran or Surviving Spouse/Domestic Partner of Veteran or Service Person, available at your local Tax Assessor or Tax Collector.
- If you are a Senior Citizen, Disabled Person or a Surviving Spouse of a Senior, this program has a \$10,000 income cap, not including social security or government pensions collected.

To qualify you must fil out the \$250 Real Property Tax Deduction Supplemental Income Form available through your Tax Assessor or Tax Collector.

Homestead Benefit

The *Homestead Benefit program* provides property tax relief to eligible homeowners. For most homeowners, the *benefit* is distributed to your municipality in the form of a credit, which reduces your property taxes. These Income limits are set by the State of NJ and are subject to change.

You may be eligible if:

- You owned and occupied a home in NJ that was your principal residence as of October of the filing year.
- Your Gross NJ income for the filing year was \$150,000 or less if you are 65 years or older OR
- Your Gross NJ income for the filing year was \$75,000 or less for home owners under 65 years old.
- Your property taxes were paid for the filing year.

Property Tax Reimbursement Program also known as "Senior Tax Freeze"

- NJ resident continuously for the last 10 years, reside in your current property continuously for the last 3 years.
- Must be 65 years old (or older) or disabled for 2 years prior to applying.
- Income requirements must be met –based on **gross** income. State of NJ sets income requirements annually. Questions/Applications: 1-800-882-6597
