Communicating When Words Are Challenging

Language is a huge part of being human. So big, we take it for granted. "Hello!" "How are you?" "What time will you be there?" We assume we will always be able to use these phrases and more. For some people with various illnesses and disabilities, spoken language becomes a much bigger challenge. Medical problems like Parkinson's Disease, stroke, traumatic brain disorders, dementia, and others can challenge the most articulate person and make basic communication much harder.

A caregiver in the last year told me about this challenge in her daily life and suggested that others may need help with coping with it. How do you communicate with a loved one or friend after their language ability has changed? We are fortunate to have a speaker discuss this very issue at our Caregiver Night on 10/20 at 6pm at the Hopewell Township Municipal Building. Check inside the newsletter for more details.

Learn About Medicare and Resources That Can Help You With Insurance Choices

with Bob Brehon, State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP)



SHIP provides free help to New Jersey Medicare beneficiaries who have problems with, or questions about their health insurance. SHIP is a statewide program sponsored by the New Jersey Department of Human Services with major funding from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, the federal Medicare agency. Medicare beneficiaries frequently have questions about benefits and claims, supplement policies, and long-term care insurance. Volunteer counselors, trained in areas of health insurance coverage and benefits that affect Medicare beneficiaries, provide information and assistance for dealing with claims and in evaluating health insurance needs. This program will provide a basic outline of all Medicare programs, as well as federal and state assistance. Attendees will also learn how to get additional assistance if needed.
