New Medicare cards will be issued
*Be sure Medicare has your correct mailing address by calling [1-800-medicare](tel:1-800-medicare).

WHEN? Beginning April 2018 through end of 2019

WHY? For YOUR security – Medicare is....

Replacing Social Security numbers on your card
With random digits and letters

What is the **SCAM** - A phone call or email stating...

“You will lose Medicare benefits if you don’t get the new card”

- You must pay for your new card
- **Asks** you to verify your existing Medicare #
- Congress requires a fee for the new card
- Fee must come out of your checking account
- **Requests** your checking account # and bank information

The Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)
will never call or email you requesting personal information.

The new Medicare card will be mailed to you at no charge.
